BROCK SYMPOSIUM ON EXCELLENCE IN EDUCATION

GEOFFREY CANADA, 2010 BROCK PRIZE LAUREATE



Educator, author and public advocate Geoffrey Canada has worked to help urban children escape violence and poverty through the Harlem Children's Zone (HCZ), a non-profit community-based organization he founded and has served as President and CEO for nearly 20 years. His work through HCZ was called "One of the most ambitious social experiments of our time" by the *New York Times*. HCZ serves 10,000 children at 20 sites within 100 blocks, combining education, social and medical services and building an infrastructure of support and structure around the children so they can benefit from a
