### What is this indicator?

The population of Oklahoma is a numerical count taken during the decennial US Census. Census tracts are small, relatively permanent statistical subdivisions of a county. Census tracts are delineated for most metropolitan areas and other densely populated counties by local census statistical areas committees following Census Bureau guidelines. Census tracts usually have between 2,500 and 8,000 persons and, when first delineated, are designed to be homogeneous with respect to population characteristics, economic status, and living conditions. Census tracts do not cross county boundaries. The spatial size of census tracts varies widely depending on the density of settlement. Census tract boundaries are delineated with the intention of being maintained over a long time so that statistical comparisons can be made from census to census. However, physical changes in street patterns caused by highway construction, new development, etc., may require occasional revisions; census tracts occasionally are split due to large population growth, or combined as a result of substantial population decline. ### What are the key findings?

Census tract data from 1960, 1980, and 2000 are represented in tabular format by age grouping. Some census tracts have subdivided since 1960 and may be represented as a decimal of the original tract number. Example: Tract 41 in 1960 is defined as tracts 41.01 and 41.02 in 1980. Census tracts may be added as needed and eliminated as needed.

The population growth has not been equal across Tulsa County from 1960 through 2000. Age grouping indicate growth in the 65 year and older population with a decrease in the 0 through 19 year olds. The population growth has been in the southern and eastern areas between 1960 and 1980 with an overall decline in central Tulsa County. The new growth areas from 1980 to 2000 have been far northern Tulsa county and southern Tulsa County.

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## What are the Implications?

The population of Tulsa County has moved from City of Tulsa to suburban areas. The City of Tulsa with the loss of resident population and corresponding tax revenue has significant implications for strategic services (fire and police). The suburban areas may have difficulty maintaining services, roads, and home construction to meet demand. The aging population has potential impact on services particular to their needs (sidewalks, assisted living, security).
