Applicants must be:

- Residing in a Work Release Center in Tulsa or on Monitored Home Confinement
- Within 9 months of release
- Staying in Tulsa after release
- Interested in job training
- Interested in help finding a job
- Interested in help with housing, transportation or other basic needs in order to get a job
- Interested in help with mental health or substance abuse treatment or support
- Willing to meet with a volunteer coach to support your reentry
