Job Title: Healthy Start Care Coordinator

Serves as Healthy Start care coordinator and educator, providing initial and subsequent support, referrals and education to interconception participants. Reporting to the Program Director, Healthy Women, Healthy Futures, Oklahoma. Duties include but are not limited to:

Providing interconception health and parenting education and care coordination services for Healthy Start participants (and partners). May periodically coordinate care for prenatal participants.

Refers participants to social, emotional and physical health resources to address their unique risk factors. May assist participant to schedule appointments and prepare patients to prepare provider questions, as needed and may attend appointment to provide support or clarify health condition and management instructions. Home visits as needed to assist mother with breastfeeding, health concerns, disease self-management or parenting techniques. Attends care coordinator meetings with supervisor, other care coordinators and Healthy Start Management Team meetings as indicated.

Maintains records of mother, infant and parent progress during enrollment in the Healthy Start program.

- Baccalaureate degree in nursing or social work preferred.
- Licensure as registered nurse or social worker in the State of Oklahoma.
- Two years' experience in community services preferred.
- Lactation specialist preferred.
