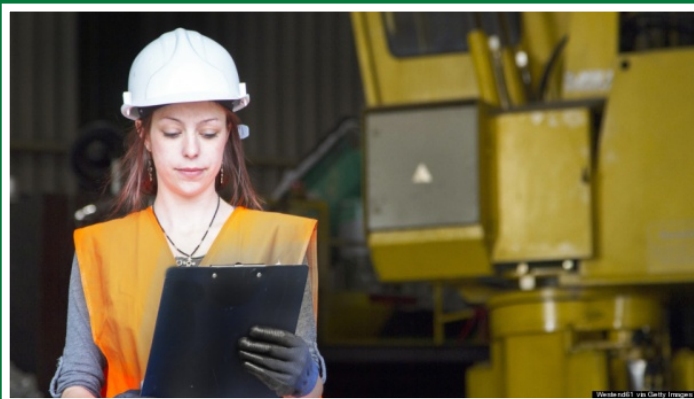


TULSA REENTRY ONE-STOP

Applicants must be:

- 18 through 24 years of age
- Released from prison within the last year, OR currently under criminal justice supervision with a sentencing date, or court order to a diversion program, within one year or less
- Residing in Tulsa
- Interested in job training to get a career, not just a job
- Eager to work
