What time is the event?

The event runs from 6-10 p.m. *Will call* ticket pickup at the Kennedy Building, 321 South Boston will begin at Noon. *Will Call* will only be open until 6 p.m. The VIP venue located on the 36th Balcony of the Mid Continent Tower will open to the VIP participants at 5:30 p.m.

Who can attend the VIP venue?

Only those individuals with VIP wristbands (gold this year) will be allowed access to the VIP venue.

How do I get my ticket/wristband?

If you have purchased tickets to **Top of the Town 2018** via our website, you had a choice to click pick up or mail for an additional \$1.50. If you checked to have your tickets mailed, we just put the wristbands in the mail. If you don't receive them by Friday, May 25, please contact us at 918-585-5551. If you chose *will call* your tickets will be waiting for you at the Kennedy Building at 321 South Boston to be picked up on event day, Thursday, June 7 between Noon and 6 p.m.

Are any tickets still available? Yes, tickets are still available for \$75.

Where do I park?

Free parking for **Top of the Town** parking all over downtown is free after 5:00 p.m. Additional paid lots are also available throughout downtown.

Where and when do I start?

You may start at any of the buildings and go on whichever route works best for you and your party. This is not a progressive event; it is a concurrent event with people at all venues at all times. Our food vendors will stop serving food at 9 p.m.

How do I get around downtown?

Walk from building to building. Top of the Town buildings are clearly marked with a sign placed in front of the building.

What is the event-night program and how do I get a copy? The event-night program is your guide to assist you in enjoying the evening and touring the buildings. Hard copies of the program will be available at each venue during the event.

How will I know which buildings are part of the *Top of the Town* event?

Top of the Town event location here signs will be posted at the doors of all participating locations. Signs will also be placed in strategic locations on the sidewalks in front of several of the building venues. Make sure you keep your *event-night program* handy as it has the venue locations on the map.

What should I wear?

Some people come directly from work so are dressed in their work clothes while others dress more casually or dress up for a date. Remember, it is June in Oklahoma so the weather could be very hot. The buildings are air-conditioned, but you will be outside roaming from one building to another. We do recommend you wear comfortable shoes.

What should I bring?

- **A camera:** to photograph beautiful views and architecture at the venues.
- **Money:** to purchase raffle tickets and restaurant pull chances. There are donation boxes at every location or you could purchase additional food or beverage from any downtown restaurant you pass on your tour.
- **Your ID** we may card you
- **Be aware:** Some elevators have a wait time and some floors or stairs are blocked at the request of the building. Please stay on the path or where you are directed in the building we are allowed to visit.

What beverages are available?

Each wristband comes with 3 alcohol beverage tickets. Check your event night program to see which locations require the drink ticket. RED wristbands are for patrons that are under 21 and drink tickets are not provided with those tickets. Water is provided in most of the buildings and you are welcome to bring your own water bottle.
