## FUNDING OPPORTUNITY FOR NEW PROGRAMS SERVING PEOPLE EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS

**WHO:** Nonprofits and local government agencies with interest in developing new programs for people experiencing homelessness.

**WHAT:** Federal HUD Continuum of Care (CoC) Program funding opportunity can provide resources for homelessness programs and housing, including\*:

- **PERMANENT SUPPORTIVE HOUSING PROJECTS** where 100% of the beds are dedicated to individuals and families experiencing **chronic homelessness** or that meet the requirements of DedicatedPLUS (long-term homelessness).
- **RAPID REHOUSING PROJECTS** that will serve homeless individuals and families, including unaccompanied youth, **or focused on survivors of domestic violence.**
- **JOINT TRANSITIONAL HOUSING + RAPID REHOUSING COMPONENT PROJECTS** to better serve homeless individuals and families, **or focused on survivors of domestic violence.**
- Supportive Services Only Projects for **COORDINATED ENTRY (CE)**, to develop or operate the CoC's CE system, **or to better equip the CE system to meet the needs of survivors of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or stalking.**

*\*Please note this is a summary based on past funding offerings – please see resources below or request information for further detail and restrictions.*

**WHERE:** Funding must be used for programs within Tulsa County.

**WHEN:** The Notice of Funding Availability could be released by HUD any time, expected in summer 2019. A Way Home for Tulsa, the local Collaborative Applicant, will distribute the funding announcement when available.
