Job Title: Healthy Start Maternal Morbidity Practitioner

PURPOSE OF POSITION:

The Healthy Start Severe Maternal Morbidity Practitioner (SMMP), a mid-level provider (advanced nurse practitioner, physician's assistant or other), will provide home based services to women residing in the Community Service Council Healthy Start's target area, who are at risk of, or who have already experienced, severe maternal morbidity (SMM). The SMMP will participate in health system collaboration with state agencies and local providers to initiate this new role in Tulsa County. Much of the SMMP's time will be focused on addressing essential elements of the SMMP role to resolve the existing gap in service provision for at risk women and their families.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

The SMMP will:

- Support women and their families through direct services, service coordination, interprofessional collaboration, and referral.
- Assess, manage, and monitor maternal acute and chronic health conditions such as anemia, hypertension, heart disease, respiratory conditions, diabetes, depression and emotional health, and delivery complications.
- Educate women and families about chronic disease and self-management interventions.
- Monitor infants'/children's health and development, particularly those children whose conditions resulted from maternal related health conditions
- Maintain patient records and enter data into data system
- Participate in system development with Oklahoma State Department of Health's MMMR, Oklahoma Perinatal Quality Improvement Collaborative (OPQIC), the

Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA), insurance companies, as well as local Tulsa area physicians and health care personnel serving families in Tulsa County.

- Assist staff, providers, payers and the community by increasing awareness of SMM and improving practice through the provision of trainings (e.g. Grand Rounds) and education (e.g. HS CAN, Sooner HAN) related to maternal warning signs during and following pregnancy.
- Participate in the development of a reimbursement system through third party payers, Medicaid (OHCA), Medicare target area providers, hospitals, and clinics.
- CSC HS Program Director and SMMP will work toward reimbursement of services through OCHA, Medicare, and private payers
- Collaborate with the Healthy Start Program Director to inform and market the new role to community stakeholders and solicit support from other MCH programs and community organizations.
- Collaborate with the HS program evaluator to determine and monitor SMMP project goals and objectives, evaluation plan, and documentation processes. The practitioner's experience(s) will be essential in determination or revision of parameters to demonstrate program effectiveness, including use of ICD10, CPT codes and other parameters, and measurement of women's access to care.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Licensed health practitioner in the state of Oklahoma
- Board certified advanced nurse practitioner (DNP, NP) physician's assistant (PA) or other
- Practice covered through own malpractice insurance
- Provider registration with OHCA for Medicaid reimbursement
- A minimum of three years clinical experience as APRN, PA, or other. Will accept APRNs with less than 3 years of experience if RN/PA has two or more years of experience in maternal-child health.
- Minimum of two years' experience with community health and maternal-child families
- Experience in providing group and individual health education to those with chronic diseases/health conditions
- Competency in data systems, electronic health records, and development of health education materials
- Current HIPAA certification
- Basic life support (BLS) Certification
- Bilingual practitioner preferred
- Breast feeding consultant/educator experience. Certification preferred.
- CITI registration preferred
